because it is a stone fruit and it is like a rock and Jews used rocks when they were slaves.

shaved chocolate

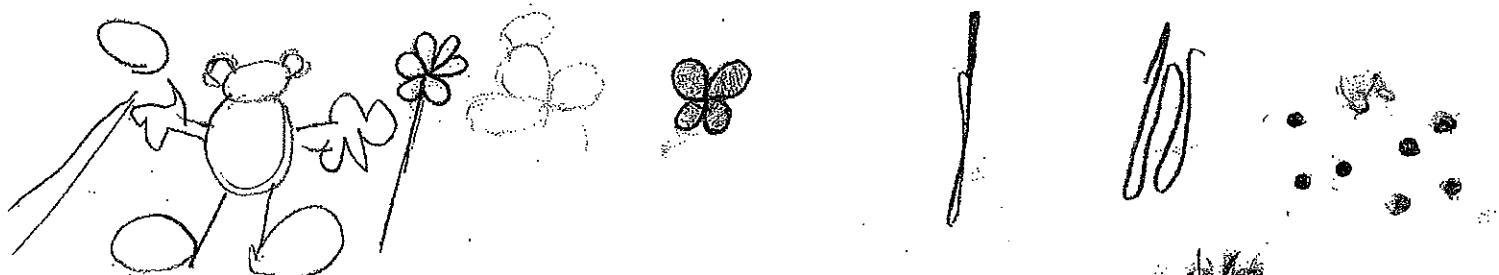
This food is a symbol of freedom
